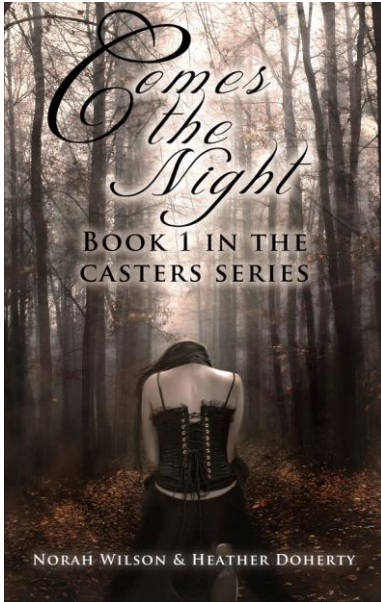


# Comes the Night

### Discussion Questions

5. Connie Harvell was horribly victimized through no fault of her own. Yet she was not weak. Name some ways in which she showed strength.
  6. All three girls have heavy burdens and/or secrets. Which one broke your heart the most?
  7. Alex chose not to report her assault at first. She had her reasons, but it was probably not the best move. How might she have handled it better? What, if anything, did she do right?
  8. There are a number of examples of peer pressure in this book, as well as examples of outright bullying. Can you name some? Did any of them resonate for you?
